The 2015 May OA Retreat

This past May, more than twenty OA fellows from Minnesota, Illinois, Wisconsin and all across the U.P. came to share in a weekend of reflection, laughter, and fellowship. Friday night kicked off the retreat with a

DVD of an interview with Rosanne, our 1960 founder. For many of us, this was the first time we had ever heard her voice or seen her face. Rosanne passed away in 2014. The L'Anse meeting graciously lent us their media resources for the retreat. After the presentation, we broke into two groups to discuss Rosanne's story.

Saturday our main speaker started the day with the question, "What did it take to get you to your first meeting?" Our responses varied, but were essentially the same: "I was desperate." Our desperation led us to embrace the miracle of the Twelve Steps and allowed us to be open to the experience, strength and hope offered by our fellows. In the afternoon, we attended a workshop on abstinence developed by the OA World Service Office. We were given a series of exercises designed to help each participant gain a better understanding of his/her plan of eating and their abstinence. The facilitator explained as a good business owner reviews their inventory yearly and reevaluates with a business plan, these exercises would benefit anyone with 1 minute to 100 years of abstinence. Two members shared their stories and responses to a list of questions pertaining to the workshop.

The group also attended our Upper Peninsula Intergroup Annual Meeting. There was much enthusiasm for next years' retreat—our 10th! Amazing! A retreat committee was formed and new officers were elected for the Intergroup. The annual minutes and financial report are included in an insert to the newsletter. Between a beautiful basket of Upper Peninsula made goods for raffle and the generosity of those giving and bidding for the silent auction, the Intergroup was able to meet the financial obligations of the retreat held at the U.P. Bible Camp in Little Lake, MI. The camp provided lovely abstinent meals and great service. Other retreat activities included Tai Chi, Mandala painting, OA meetings, and a campfire on Saturday night. With the fine weather, some folks went canoeing on the lake and/or taking hikes around the center.

- I. CALL TO ORDER: The Meeting was opened with the Serenity Prayer
Introductions: Tonya/IG Vice Chair & Acting Chairperson, Martha/IG Treasurer, Laura/Marquette, Joan/L'Anse, Carol/Houghton and Sandra/IG Secretary
- II. OLD BUSINESS
- A. Meeting Minutes from April 11, 2015 were unanimously approved as submitted.
- B. Standing Committee Reports
1. Treasurer's Report: Martha reported she received the financial report from Debbie (outgoing IG Treasurer) after May's retreat. 2015 Checking account starting balance was \$1,437.11. Revenues: \$221.00 in donations from OA UP groups, \$3,023.00 from the retreat and \$0.09 checking account earned interest. Expenses: \$2,744.46 for the retreat and \$109.61 other. Checking balance 6/1/2015: \$1,827.13. Treasurer's report was approved as reported.
 2. Newsletter Update: Laura reported that she will be getting a newsletter out soon. She had planned to have one to distribute at the retreat but it didn't work out. She was given/will include April's quarterly IG Minutes, the IG Annual Meeting Minutes, the annual Treasurer's Report & review of the retreat she received from Tonya. Laura mentioned that the newsletter is set up to go out quarterly, with the spring issue to include annual reports and articles from the IG Committee Members. She hopes to have one for next year's retreat.
 3. Outreach Committee Update: Tonya reported that the retreat was successful in spreading the word of OA. A few attendees hadn't been here before. Joan reported that the two L'Anse OA groups are sponsoring an abstinence workshop October 13th at the United Methodist Church on Main St. in L'Anse. Laura will do the presentation, the same one from the retreat, which is the Abstinence Workshop that OA's World Service put together. There will be 2 OA speakers from Bayfield, Wisconsin. The topic will include discussion on the difference between abstinence and a food plan. The workshop will be around 4 hours with water and coffee provided. Joan suggested bringing a bag lunch. Laura will check with the speakers to determine the exact times which she will post in the newsletter. OA 'Have You Taken The Test' posters that members put up in local areas: Only one member present had any response. Tonya suggested that we discuss PI (public information) at the next quarterly IG meeting.
 4. 2016 UP OA Retreat Committee Report: Tonya reported that next year's retreat committee has already met. They hopefully have secured the UP Bible Camp again for next year. It looks as though the only available weekend is April 29-May 1. The retreat committee will be meeting again in September.
- C. Website: Tonya talked to Mike D. He's unable to log in to update the website. She mentioned this is a very common problem with our software. Mike was unable to get the help he needs from Region 5. He suggested getting a consultant to help him. Laura said that when she talked to Mike he seemed too busy to do the research to find out what it would take to get the problem resolved. Tonya indicated that it must be done locally. She will continue working with Mike to get a clearer picture of what the issue is but she has limited knowledge of web postings. With that said, a motion was made and approved to provide up to \$500 to Mike for a consultant. Tonya will contact Mike.

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned and closed with the Serenity Prayer.

- I can see the importance of not forgetting where I came from. The 12 Steps are the basic core of how I can live the life I'm living.
- Progress - not perfection! The only step I need to do perfectly is step 1.
- Any negative self-talk is not okay!
- Experienced a moment of calm during Peg's talk - an expansiveness!
- I love the U.P. retreat. Compassion and love.
- You guys are the miracle for me. I'm not going to run away!
- Helping to plan this retreat was an act of love. I experienced the "Jesus" in each person
- I looked forward to coming here. Came for the fellowship and support. I'm grateful to be walking this path with you guys. My life is in OA.
- How loving and not judged I feel; I think of Titanic - the people in the water - it doesn't matter who we are when we are in the freezing drink.
- I see the love in your eyes and I think, "I get to take this home!!"
- I came without expectation, but I did feel vulnerable. I hate walking into a group of strangers. This group made it easy. I had a weekend of reflection.
